

# GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION

*The Journal of Forensic Document Examination (JFDE)* is an official publication of the Association of Forensic Document Examiners. *JFDE* publishes papers that include the following types:

1. **Research Papers** - Original papers covering the author's in-depth research of a topic related to document examination, including full documentation. Research papers must contain an abstract and full bibliography. Papers must begin with a statement of purpose, and end with a statement of findings.

2. **Case Analysis** - Brief reports of unusual cases. No paper dealing with a case still in litigation will be considered. Indicate in your introduction what was unusual about the case you are reporting and summarize your findings.

3. **Technically Speaking** - Reports of varying length on techniques, materials, processes or instruments related to document examination. These submissions may be expressive of the author's point of view and need not include a bibliography, unless references are cited.

4. **Commentaries/Book Reviews** - We welcome readers' suggestions of relevant new books for our review.

Preference is given to members of the Association of Forensic Document Examiners (AFDE) and the International Graphonomics Association (IGS) in the reading and acceptance of manuscripts, but original material submitted by nonmembers, who are employed as professional document examiners, graduate students in forensic science, or by recognized experts in related forensic fields, will also be considered. Publication will depend upon space available and suitability for inclusion in the *JFDE*, as determined by the Editorial Board. *JFDE* editors reserve the right to clarify and/or condense any material submitted for publication, but request that authors submit only work they believe to be in finished form and suitable for our format.

Previously published materials will be considered, but must be accompanied by release from all previous publishers; such release remains the responsibility of the author. All material appearing in the *JFDE* is copyrighted by AFDE.

## Requirements for submission of papers

To ensure that the *JFDE* can accept papers, please follow the guidelines:

### Step 1 - Peer review

Send double-spaced papers in Microsoft Word, along with a statement that the paper has not been previously published and is the original work of the author (s). The papers should either within the text or separately incorporate figures, tables and images with captions. Once the author has received the comments from the peer reviewers, made the recommended changes and the paper has received final approval from the editor for publication, authors must follow the next steps. The authors will not know who the specific peer reviewers are for their papers, but the peer reviewers may be acknowledged as a group in the *JFDE* for their time and contributions.

## Step 2 - Submission for publication

- Send an electronic copy of the text of the paper in Microsoft Word. **Do not include the figures, tables or images within the text.** Send separate pages for the captions and for each figure, table and image. List where each should be inserted into the text. Figures, tables and images sent as MS Word files deteriorate when imported into Adobe InDesign and cannot be used. In addition, these figures, tables and images cannot be resized to fit into the layout when they are included within the MS Word text.
- If sending images, tables and figures by E-mail, send them as separate JPEG or Adobe PDF files at 300 dpi. When scanning the images use graphics programs wherever possible such as Adobe Photoshop, Microsoft Publisher, etc. to ensure that the images will be clearly reproduced. If the paper is provided on a CD or DVD, then files can be sent as JPEG, Adobe PDF (or other high quality PDF formats), TIFF or Bitmap files.
- Grant permission in writing to reproduce the paper in the *JFDE*. Sending this permission via the lead author's E-mail is acceptable.

Bibliographical material must conform to the style of the *American Psychological Association Publication Manual*. Include a title page with the author's name and correspondence address (if more than one author, please designate one address.) Indicate highest academic degree. Include an abstract, a list of keywords, and a brief biographical note relevant to questioned document work for each author.
